



Letter Swap

The Needlework Show puzzle contest

At this meet, we're swapping letters. For instance, LETTER and SWAP can exchange the L and W to make WETTER and SLAP. In this puzzle, you'll swap a letter from a word in the left column with a letter from a word in the right column. Write the letter you exchange on the space provided. Read down the letters on the spaces to reveal two new words. Swap letters from the two new words to reveal the puzzle answer. (This answer will make sense--sort of--unlike the answers in the New Puzzle Pattern Contest last month!)

Come on. We'll do one together to get you in the groove.

Example: (senior) S SENSOR ————— S BILLOWS (billowy)
 (tape) L TALE ————— I MARTINI (martini)
 (grass) Y GRAYS ————— P PARK (lark)

The two new words on the spaces are SLY and SIP. If we swap the S in SLY for the P in SIP, we wind up with PLY and SIS as the answer to the puzzle.

Now try this one:

<u> </u> ELATE	<u> </u> BIRD
<u> </u> PROTECT	<u> </u> COMICAL
<u> </u> RUNT	<u> </u> LOPPED
<u> </u> PAISLEY	<u> </u> HALL

<u> </u> INNATE	<u> </u> CONCERT
